Rising Bollards

The Problem

To reduce traffic cutting through the estate, rising bollards are in operation at the southern, Peveril Drive entrance/exit of The Park which leads to Castle Boulevard. The bollards operate on Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR). Residents of the estate can register their car in order to be able to use the Peveril Drive entrance/exit. When you register your vehicle for a parking permit with the NPEL you will also be registered for ANPR.

The Process

Automatic Numberplate Recognition (ANPR) at the rising Bollards on Peveril Drive

Once NPEL have issued a parking permit or confirmed your registration is on the ANPR system you can gain access at the rising bollards. When you approach the bollards there is a post on the driver's side with an amber light on top. If the system recognises your registration the amber light will flash, proceed to the stop line on the tarmac and wait for the next set of lights to go green once the bollard is fully lowered. If the amber light doesn't flash, don't try to go through, contact the NPEL office .

Emergency Vehicle Access

Emergency vehicles are able to use the Peveril Drive entrance/exit. The three emergency services provide their registration details to The Park Office as well as other bodies within the city that have similar restrictions. It is the responsibility of the emergency services to provide this information
